The Work of the Holy Spirit in Prayer

Believe it or not, we as Reformed Christians actually believe in the Holy Spirit and in prayer! So what is the connection between the two? Join the Oceanside URC's *Wednesday Study in Theology* this September as we answer that question.

We will be utilizing one of the works of John Owen (1616–83). Owen was the greatest and most voluminous theologian in the English-speaking world in the seventeenth century, earning him the names, “The Prince of Puritans” and “The Calvin of England.” It is estimated that he wrote over **8 million words** with only a quill pen!

Among his volumes of works are several treatises on the person and work of the Holy Spirit, one of which is a powerful treatise he wrote at the end of his life in 1682, “*A Discourse of the Work of the Holy Spirit in Prayer*.” In this work, Owen discusses the role of the Holy Spirit in the corporate prayers of the church and in the private prayers of Christians.

This Fall Pastor Hyde will resume teaching our *Wednesday Study in Theology* as he lectures on the vital topic of the Spirit and prayer and as we discuss its benefits for the life of the church, our families, and our personal lives.

He earned his Bachelor's (B.A.) from Vanguard University and Master of Divinity (M.Div.) from Westminster Seminary California. Currently, he is a Master of Theology (Th.M.) candidate at Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary in Grand Rapids, working under Dr. Joel Beeke on a thesis entitled, “The Liturgical Theology of John Owen.” Pastor Hyde is the author of eight books, including two scheduled for publication in 2010: *Welcome to a Reformed Church: An Introduction* (Reformation Trust/Ligonier) and *In Defense of the Descent: A Confessional Response to Contemporary Critics of Christ's Descent into Hell* (Reformation Heritage Books).
